Five Recycling Principles

Deduces	
Reduce:	Lessen your consumption
Reuse:	As often as possible
Return:	Use when you need and return what you can
Reclaim:	Hold events to reclaim out of service, out of date, obsolete, broken and unwanted
	electronics. Typically we harvest elements from the e-waste for reuse.
Rebuild/	About 80% of reclaimed e-waste is reused by responsible manufacturers and
Refurbish:	recyclers around the world.



Data on all donated items is automatically destroyed magnetically and you will be issued a certificate of destruction by the agency carrying out that process in accordance with federal regulations.
