program eligibility

is based on 3 criteria

1. NEED

- Overcrowded
- Too expensive or has very high utilities (more than 30% of gross monthly income)
- Unsafe or unhealthy
- Inaccessible to a disabled family member
- Homeless, in transitional housing, or living with family/ friends

2. Partnership

- All partners complete "sweat equity" hours.
- Habitat highlights these volunteer and education hours as part of the opportunity of giving people and up, not a hand out

3. Ability to Pay

- Income must be reliable, sustainable and verifiable. Minimum credit score of 550 is required
- Income must be within established Habitat guidelines.

Additional Requirements

Permanent resident or citizen of the United States at the time of application.

program eligibility

Accessibility ramps are available to assist with mobility needs for:

- Homeowners
- Owner of mobile homes

Ramps are offered at a significantly reduced cost.

- repair/replace windows, doors, gutters, siding, roof
- repair porch or stairs
- house paint
- landscaping

program eligibility

- own and reside in the home needing repairs for at least 18 months
- current on mortgage and taxes for the property
- have an active homeowners insurance policy
- meet income qualifications
- willing to partner and complete sweat equity
- able to provide all application paperwork in a timely manner
- do not have any household members who appear on the sex offender registry

repair project costs

- assessed on site and scope of work is agreed upon between Habitat and homeowner through a comprehensive quote
- homeowner is responsible for a percentage of that cost based on income
- option to have a custom loan product through a preferred lender to pay over time

Habitat Income Guidelines

Houston County Habitat for Humanity selects families to purchase homes in a way that does not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, color, age, handicap, religion, marital status, or because all or part of the applicant's income is derived from public assistance programs.

Income must meet within 30-70% median household income for Houston County.

You must meet monthly income guidelines based of HUD's Home Income Guideline:
