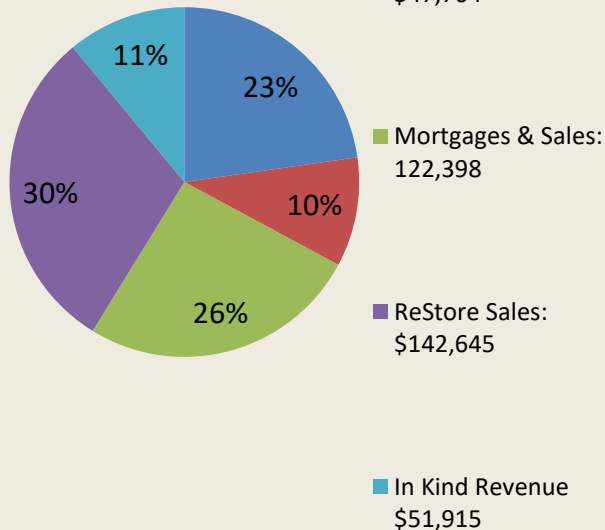

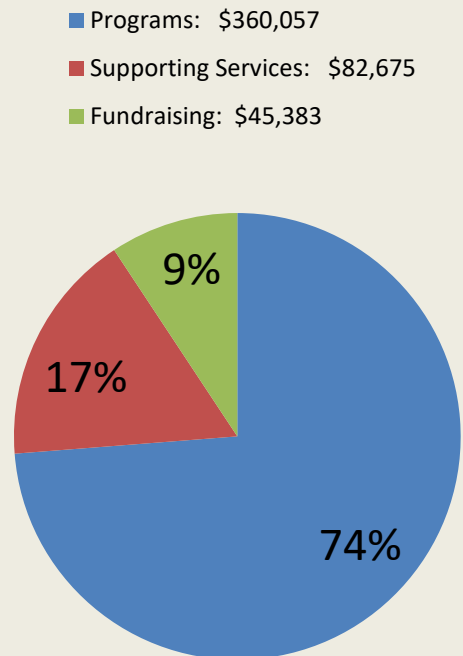
- ✓ Our first ever Annual Campaign raised over \$200,000 for the calendar year 2017.
